TOWNSHIP CLEAN-UP WEEK October 21 thru 25

The BIG dumpsters will be available at township hall for residents to dispose of household items, appliances, steel and metal. The township will pay for Freon removal from appliances. Employees will be on hand from 7 a.m. to 7 p.m. Monday through Thursday and on Friday from 7 a.m. until the end of clean-up at 11 a.m. to assist you with unloading your vehicle. **DO NOT** bring tires, brush, oil, paint, batteries, boats, vehicles or propane tanks. Scrapping for metal is **PROHIBITED** and will be enforced by the Danbury Township Police Department. This is the last clean-up week of 2013.

OUR RESIDENTIAL RECYCLING SERVICE is located at the Police Station at 419 S. Bridge Road. The service is available 7 days a week during daylight hours.

THE ONLY ITEMS ACCEPTED ARE: Glass bottles and jars, aluminum and steel cans, plastics stamped #1 and #2 and plastic containers stamped #3 through #7, flattened cardboard boxes and cartons (including juice and soy milk cartons), junk mail, computer paper, phone books, magazines and newspapers including inserts. **PLEASE...**rinse bottles, jars, cans and cartons and remove the lids. All containers that hold liquid must be empty.

Recycling is for residential use only...not for businesses. Thank you!
