

THE LAST TOWNSHIP CLEAN-UP WEEK OF THE YEAR!

The BIG dumpsters will be at township hall for residents to dispose of household items, appliances, steel and metal. We will pay for Freon removal from appliances. Employees will be on hand from 7 a.m. to 7 p.m. Monday thru Thursday and on Friday from 7 a.m. until the end of clean-up at 11 a.m. They will be available to assist you while you unload your vehicle. **DO NOT** bring tires, brush, oil, paint, batteries, boats, vehicles or propane tanks. Scrapping for metal is **PROHIBITED** and will be enforced by the Danbury Township Police Department. Clean-up weeks will be held again next year.

PLEASE HELP!! Metal pieces dumped at the brush drop-off site destroyed part of the grinding equipment. Please...the residential brush drop-off is **ONLY** for limbs and branches. Brush drop-off will **close for the season** on November 30. We ask that you don't overload your vehicle when coming to brush drop-off. Branches & limbs fall on the road and your taillights are not visible to other people. **Thank you!!**

RESIDENTIAL LEAF DROP-OFF will be open during October & November (and again in April and May) during daylight hours at 310 S. Bridge Road (just behind the off-leash dog park fence). We are no longer providing bio-degradable bags so please bring loose leaves. If you do bring leaves in a bag, empty the bag of leaves then take the bag back home with you.
