A zoning permit IS needed for single-family residential, multi-family/condo developments, non-residential commercial and industrial buildings, additions, signs, accessory structures (sheds, garages, gazebos), pools, porches & decks, fences, change of use, home occupations, boat docks, remodeling and all nonconforming (grandfathered) uses & structures.

FEMA is preparing new Flood Insurance Rate Maps for Ottawa and surrounding counties. Ottawa County adopted new maps in 2015 but FEMA's changed maps will replace the current ones. FEMA anticipates their new maps will be ready for adoption within the next 2 to 3 years. During that time frame they will conduct public meetings and community outreach for residents to attend and comment.
