Employees will be on hand from 7 a.m. to 7 p.m. Monday thru Thursday and on Friday from 7 a.m. until the end of clean-up at 11 a.m. They will be available to assist you while you unload your vehicle. **DO NOT** bring tires, brush, oil, paint, batteries, boats, vehicles or propane tanks. Scrapping for metal is **PROHIBITED** and will be enforced by the Danbury Township Police Department. Clean-up weeks will be held again next year.

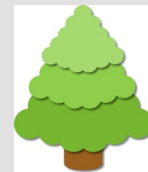
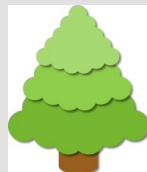

**LAND USE PLAN UPDATE:** In June, two community open houses were held to get input from residents and business owners. A comment period was also extended thru the middle of July. The Steering Committee took the 130 comments and ideas from the 47 participants and grouped them into categories related to Land Use, Community Facilities & Services, Transportation, Economic Development and Housing. Draft goals and objectives were created using the comments received as the strategies. The group is about one month behind in the process but is starting to work on creating the map component for the update. Once this is completed, please look for news releases about another opportunity for public review and input prior to the plan entering the adoption process.
