



TOWNSHIP CLEAN-UP WEEK October 15 thru 19

The BIG dumpsters will be available at township hall for residents to dispose of household items, appliances, steel and metal. The township will pay for Freon removal from appliances. Employees will be on hand from 7 a.m. to 7 p.m. Monday through Thursday and on Friday from 7 a.m. until the end of clean-up at 11 a.m. to assist you with unloading your vehicle. **DO NOT** bring tires, brush, oil, paint, batteries, boats, vehicles or propane tanks. This is the last clean-up week of 2012.



ZONING OFFICE HAS NEW HOURS

In order to better serve the public Danbury Township has changed the open hours at the zoning office. The new hours are: Monday, Tuesday, Thursday and Friday from 9 a.m. until 4 p.m. On Wednesdays the zoning office will be open from 9 a.m. to 11 a.m. then again from 4 p.m. to 6:30 p.m. Zoning Inspector Kathryn Dale can be reached at (419) 734-6120 or by email: zoning@danburytownship.com. If you do bring leaves in a bag, empty the bag of leaves then take the bag back home with you.

THE EXPLORATORY FIRE AND EMS COMMITTEE



NEW DROP-OFF SERVICE FOR UNWANTED MEDICATIONS STARTING SOON

The township received a grant from the Joint Solid Waste District for a secure drop box for residents to dispose of their unwanted medications. The box will be located at the police station and the service will be free to residents. All you will need to do is call the police department to make arrangements with the officer on duty. In addition to this service the police department also offers free secure document shredding by appointment. Press releases will be sent when the prescription drop box arrives. OUR RECYCLING SERVICE HAS CHANGED and MOVED!

New recycling containers and more frequent pick-ups will soon be offered. AND...beginning September 10 all recycling will be located at 419 S. Bridge Road (SR 269 South) which is also the site of our Police Station. Pull in the drive and you'll see the containers on your immediate right. This service is available 7 days a week during daylight hours and is only for residential use, not for businesses.

THE ONLY ITEMS ACCEPTED ARE: Glass bottles and jars, aluminum and steel cans, plastics stamped #1 and #2 and plastic containers stamped #3 through #7, flattened cardboard boxes and cartons (including juice and soy milk cartons), junk mail, office paper, phone books, magazines and newspapers including inserts. **PLEASE**...rinse bottles, jars, cans and cartons and remove the lids. All containers that hold liquid must be empty.
