RESOLUTION 008-2016

**A RESOLUTION REQUESTING THE OTTAWA COUNTY AUDITOR TO  
CERTIFY AMOUNTS OF TAX GENERATED BY PROPOSED  
ADDITIONAL LEVY**

**For the purposes of providing additional funds for the purpose of  
constructing permanent improvements to and further improving the  
Danbury Township Hall as authorized by Ohio Revised Code Sections  
5705.19(F), 511.01, and 511.02**

The Board of Township Trustees of Danbury Township, Ottawa County, Ohio met in open Special Session at 5:15 p.m. on the 4th day of August, 2016, at the Danbury Township offices in Danbury Township, Ohio, 5972 East Port Clinton Eastern Road, Marblehead, Ohio 43440, with the following members present:

Mr./Ms. Scott introduced the following Resolution and moved its adoption.

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OTTAWA COUNTY  
BOARD OF ELECTIONS

WHEREAS, the amount of taxes which may be raised within the ten (10) mill limitation will be insufficient to provide an adequate amount of revenue for the necessary requirements of Danbury Township, including for the permanent and class of improvements to the Danbury Township Hall; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary to levy an additional tax in excess of the ten (10) mill limitation for the purpose providing additional funds for one (1) year for the tax duplicate year of 2016 for the construction of permanent improvements or class of improvements as authorized by Ohio Revised Code Sections 5705.19(F), 511.01, and 511.02; and

WHEREAS, the specific amount of millage necessary to generate the additional funds needed for such purposes is unknown at the present time due to reappraisal of property with the Township which is occurring or has recently occurred, necessitating that the Ottawa County Auditor be requested to certify separately the amounts which would be generated by a replacement levy at more than a single millage in order that the Board may then determine the millage amount to be placed on the ballot for the electors of the Township; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of Danbury Township, Ottawa County, Ohio, the taxing authority in the Township, certifies to Lawrence Hartlaub, Ottawa County Auditor, this resolution requesting that he certify to the Board of Trustees of Danbury Township, Ottawa County, Ohio by one certificate, the total current tax

valuation of the subdivision, and the dollar amount of revenue that would be generated by the following millage in excess of the ten (10) mill limit for the purposes of providing additional funds for permanent improvements and class of improvements to the Danbury Township Hall as authorized by Sections 5705.19(F), 511.01, and 511.02 of the Ohio Revised Code:

One and 65/100 (1.65) mills

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this Board hereby finds and determines that all formal actions relative to the adoption of this Resolution were taken in an open Special Meeting of this Board, and that all deliberations of this Board and of its committees, if any, which resulted in formal action were taken in meetings open to the public in full compliance with applicable legal requirements including §121.22 of the Revised Code.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this Resolution is declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, safety and welfare of the Township, and for the further reasons that this Resolution be effective immediately so that it can be timely filed with the County Auditor and any additional proceedings taken in order to submit the question of the levy to the Electors at the November 8, 2016 General Election; wherefore this Resolution shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Clerk Treasurer.

Mr. Ms. Rozak seconded the motion; on the roll call being called upon the adoption of the foregoing resolution, the vote resulted as follows:

## Certificate of Estimated Property Tax Revenue


Use this form when a taxing authority certifies a millage rate and requests the revenue produced by that rate.

The county auditor of Ottawa County, Ohio, does hereby certify the following:


1. On August 4, 2016, the taxing authority of the Danbury Township (political subdivision name) certified a copy of its resolution or ordinance adopted August 4, 2016, requesting the county auditor to certify the current tax valuation of the subdivision and the amount of revenue that would be produced by One and 65/100 (1 .65) mills, to levy a tax outside the 10-mill limitation for Permanent Improvemen purposes pursuant to Revised Code § 5705.19 (F), to be placed on the ballot at the November 8, 2016, election. The levy type is an additional.

2. The estimated property tax revenue that will be produced by the stated millage, assuming the tax valuation of the subdivision remains constant throughout the life of the levy, is calculated to be \$ 303,567,530.

3. The total tax valuation of the subdivision used in calculating the estimated property tax revenue is \$ 500,880

### Instructions

1. "Total tax valuation" includes the taxable value of all real property in the subdivision as indicated on the tax list most recently certified for collection and estimates of the taxable value of personal and public utility personal property for the first year the levy will be collected as set forth on the worksheets prescribed in conjunction with this form. If the subdivision is located in more than one county, the home county auditor (where the greatest taxable value of the subdivision is located) shall obtain the assistance of the other county auditors to establish the total tax valuation of the subdivision.
2. For purposes of this certification, "subdivision" includes any agency, board, commission or other authority authorized to request a taxing authority to submit a tax levy on its behalf.
3. "Levy type" includes the following: (1) additional, (2) renewal, (3) renewal with an increase, (4) renewal with a decrease, (5) replacement, (6) replacement with an increase and (7) replacement with a decrease levies.
4. Please file this certificate with the subdivision as soon as possible, so the taxing authority can pass a resolution to proceed not later than 90 days before the election.
