TOWNSHIP CLEAN UP WEEK

April 15 through 19

The BIG dumpsters will be at township hall for residents to dispose of household items, appliances, steel and metal. We will pay for Freon removal from appliances. Employees will be on hand from 7 a.m. to 7 p.m. Monday thru Thursday and on Friday from 7 a.m. until the end of clean-up at 11 a.m. to assist you with unloading your vehicle. **DO NOT** bring tires, brush, oil, paint, batteries, boats, vehicles or propane tanks. Clean-up will also be held the weeks of July 22 and October 21.

BRUSH DROP-OFF OPENS APRIL 1

Follow the driveway and signs at 310 Bridge Road (SR 269 South) to drop off your branches and limbs. **DO NOT** bring stumps or grass clippings. We are only able to process limbs and branches. This service is available during daylight hours and is only for residents. Contractors are **NOT** permitted to use this service.



LEAF DROP-OFF FOR RESIDENTS WILL BE OPEN...

...only during April and May at the brush drop-off site. You must use biodegradable bags or bring loose leaves.



NEED MULCH?? Come to the brush drop-off site at 310 Bridge Road (SR 269 South) and we'll load you up with free mulch on the following dates (**while supplies last!**): Every Monday from 8 a.m. to 9 a.m. beginning April 1 until we run out of mulch (no distribution on April 15, May 27 or July 22) and on the following Saturdays: April 6 and 20 and May 4 and 18 from 8 a.m. until noon.
