BRUSH DROP-OFF OPENS

APRIL 1

at 310 Bridge Road (SR 269 South behind the dog park) to drop off branches and limbs.

DO NOT bring stumps or grass clippings. We can only process limbs and branches.

This service is available during daylight hours and is only for residents.

Contractors are NOT permitted to use this service.

LEAF DROP-OFF FOR RESIDENTS WILL BE OPEN

only during April and May at the brush drop-off site. You must use biodegradable bags or bring loose leaves.

CEMETERY CLEAN-UP BEGINS APRIL 1

If you wish to save anything please remove it from the gravesite prior to this date.

TOWNSHIP CLEAN-UP WEEK

April 20 through 24

The BIG dumpsters will be at township hall for residents to dispose of household items, appliances, steel and metal. We will pay for Freon removal from appliances. Employees will be on hand from 7 a.m. to 7 p.m. Monday thru Thursday and on Friday from 7 a.m. until the end of clean-up at 11 a.m. They will assist you as you unload your vehicle.

DO NOT bring tires, brush, oil, paint, batteries, boats, vehicles or propane tanks. Scrapping for metal is **PROHIBITED** and will be enforced by the Danbury Township Police Department.

Clean-up will also be held the weeks of July 20 and October 19.

DANBURY TOWNSHIP HALL is a designated **EMERGENCY SHELTER** during severe weather. The police will open Township Hall within a few minutes after the sirens are activated. Please remember the sirens are tested on the 1st Friday each month at noon.

RESIDENTS are invited to serve on our zoning boards. Call Kathryn Dale at (419) 734-6120 to learn more. Danbury Township must be your residence of record for you to be appointed to a zoning board.

When calling 911 from your cell phone please give your exact location to the dispatcher including that you are located in Ottawa County. Providing the name of our county will assist the dispatcher in the rare event your call bounces to another county's cell tower.

TELEPHONE SCAMS

You may have heard about it, read about it or already received a phone call from someone purporting to be from the IRS or any one of a number of companies. These illegal solicitors will threaten you if you don't "pay up". If you receive such a call you should inform the caller you are contacting the police as soon as you hang up. **NEVER SEND MONEY.** Call the police if you get such a call.


