

## **CEMETERY SOFTWARE**

## **MOSQUITO SEASON IS HERE**

We explored spraying (fogging) ditches for mosquitos but decided against it for safety reasons. You can treat standing water on your property with mosquito “dunks” that are available at a reasonable cost in the lawn and garden department of most stores. They are said to kill the pesky creatures for up to 30 days and each one will treat 100 square feet of water.

## **WEATHER WARNING SIRENS**

The county-wide weather sirens are tested on the first Friday of each month at noon. If you hear them any other time, you should immediately tune into local media for more information and take shelter if necessary. The sirens are used for a tornado warning issued by the National Weather Service, an actual tornado spotted by trained personnel in the county, a chemical release or a train derailment. You can also check the Ottawa County Emergency Management Agency (OCEMA) website: [www.co.ottawa.oh.us/ottawacoema](http://www.co.ottawa.oh.us/ottawacoema) for information and details about these emergencies. Danbury Township Hall located at 5972 Port Clinton Eastern Road is a severe weather shelter. The east door of the hall will be opened by a police officer if the sirens are sounded for a weather event or other type of emergency. The hall is a temporary shelter for limited use during these events.
