Scrapping for metal is **PROHIBITED** and will be enforced by the Danbury Township Police Department. Clean-up will also be held the week of October 19.



The township trustees have again requested a traffic light at the intersection of State Route 163, N. Shore Blvd. and Englebeck Road. ODOT has agreed to perform another traffic study this summer to decide if it is warranted. Our previous request for a light was denied.
