

RAINBOW RIDGE

As you approach the lower main entrance to Danbury Township's Meadowbrook Marsh on Bayshore Road your first view is that of a ridge overlooking the meadow, forest and pond. The Danbury Trustees will formally rename this portion of the preserve "*Rainbow Ridge*" in memory of the beloved wildlife that perished during a tragic fire on Thanksgiving Day 2019 at the home of our neighbors - African Safari Wildlife Park.

The ridge will remain a serene area to reflect and forever remember the grief-stricken day our devastated community came together to collectively share their tears.

As donations allow, Rainbow Ridge will have a commemorative sign, tall grasses, a bench, a memory box for all to share their thoughts and a path connecting to the main trail. The contents of the memory box will continually be placed on a special page of the township's website. A public dedication will occur in late Spring 2020.
