**PUBLIC NOTICE EFFECTIVE IMMEDIATELY – MARCH 16, 2020
REGARDING CORONAVIRUS (COVID-19)**

In accordance with recommendations from the Ohio Department of Health and the Governor of the State of Ohio, Danbury Township will be limiting access to the Township buildings until further notice. In-person meetings with staff or elected officials will be held by appointment only. These precautions are in place to ensure both the safety of the Township employees, residents and property owners within our Township. Township business during this time will be conducted as follows:

POLICE DEPARTMENT In case of emergency dial 9-1-1. For all other inquiries call the non-emergency number: (419) 732-2549. You are asked to call first before coming to the department.

FIRE DEPARTMENT In cases of emergency dial 9-1-1. For all other inquiries call the non-emergency number (419) 798-5219. You are asked to call first before coming to the department.

SERVICE DEPARTMENT Service Department staff will continue to operate as normal. Township parks and shelter houses can be used as normal. Direct contact with the crew while out in the field should be limited. Brush drop-off and free mulch remains in place. Road-related questions and questions regarding cemetery records or arrangements should be directed to (419) 734-4091.
