CEMETERY CLEAN-UP BEGINS APRIL 1

Remove what you wish to save prior to this date.

APRIL & MAY IS LEAF DROP-OFF AT THE BRUSH SITE

Bring loose leaves or use biodegradable bags.

FREE MULCH BEGINNING APRIL 1

Help yourself to mulch at the brush drop-off site during daylight hours while supplies last.
