## HOUSEHOLD HAZARDOUS WASTE - May 1, September 4

**REGISTER APRIL 1-30 FOR MAY 1 EVENT. LIMITED TO 1,200 HOUSEHOLDS.**

**REGISTER AUG 19 - SEPT 13 FOR SEPT 4 EVENT. LIMITED TO 1,200 HOUSEHOLDS.**

- Accepting fluorescent/CFL bulbs and household **rechargeable batteries** - **No longer accepting alkaline batteries.**
- All automotive fluids & fuels, hand-held propane cylinders, motor oil, marine & auto flares.
- Household cleaners, household pesticides/herbicides/fungicides/insecticides, inhalers & used cooking oil.
- Oil paints, wood stains, aerosols, primers, thinners, strippers, sealers, tars, adhesives and coatings.
- For instructions to dispose of latex paint properly at your home, contact the District's main office.
- Bring in your old mercury thermometer and exchange it for a free digital thermometer.
- **Fluids will not be accepted in containers larger than 5 gallons.**



## TELEVISIONS & ELECTRONICS - May 8, July 10, September 25

**ATTENTION: NOT ACCEPTING ANY TYPE OF CONSOLE OR PROJECTION SCREEN TV's.**

**REGISTER APRIL 1 - MAY 2 FOR MAY 8 EVENT. LIMITED TO 600 HOUSEHOLDS.**

**REGISTER JUNE 1 - JULY 4 FOR JULY 10 EVENT. LIMITED TO 600 HOUSEHOLDS.**

**REGISTER AUG 19 - SEPT 19 FOR SEPT 25 EVENT. LIMITED TO 600 HOUSEHOLDS.**

- Accepting only standard glass tube televisions. The District **CHARGES** to recycle glass tube TV's.
- TV's 24" or less - **\$5.00**
- TV's 25" & larger - **\$10.00**
- **NO CHARGE** for Electronics (LCD/LED or Plasma TV's, computers, CD/DVD players, stereos)



## APPLIANCES - May 22 (OTTAWA COUNTY ONLY), October 16 (ALL THREE COUNTIES)

**REGISTER MAY 3-20 FOR MAY 22 EVENT (OTTAWA COUNTY ONLY). LIMITED TO 150 HOUSEHOLDS.**

**REGISTER OCT 2 - 15 FOR OCTOBER 16 EVENT. LIMITED TO 450 HOUSEHOLDS.**

- Any appliance or household object made primarily of steel: grills, mowers, microwaves, etc.
- No televisions, computers, plastic fans or vacuum cleaners, etc.
- Refrigerators with food inside will not be accepted.
- Units containing freon will be accepted at no charge.



## FARM TIRES - Register August 16 - August 27

- Record the quantity and height of the tires you would like to recycle. Tires will be accepted on or off the rim.
- **Register by calling 419-334-7222 or 1-888-850-7224. Date & location will be provided at this time.**
- **NO DEALERS OR AGRI-BUSINESSES.**

There will be a charge to recycle farm tires:

- Implement tires up to 36" - **\$1.00** each
- Tires 37" - 60" - **\$10.00** each
- Tires 61" & larger - **\$20.00** each

## RESIDENTIAL TIRES - October 9

**REGISTER SEPT 21 - OCT 8 FOR OCTOBER 9 EVENT. LIMITED TO 450 HOUSEHOLDS**

- Limit of 10 tires per household
- Car and small truck tires - **\$1.00** each
- Accepting tires on or off the rim
- Racing tires - **\$3.00** each
