TOWNSHIP CLEAN-UP WEEK: September 28 through October 2

The big dumpsters will be at township hall for residential disposal of household items, appliances, steel and metal. We pay for Freon removal from appliances. Please see the details and rules below.

NOTE: Employees from Cyclone Services will be working our cleanup weeks.

Danbury Township Maintenance staff will be onsite during cleanup. This is the last cleanup of the year.

PLEASE REVIEW THE RULES BELOW

HOURS: 9 a.m. to 6 p.m. **Tuesday** through **Friday** and 8 a.m. to noon on **Saturday**. Dumpsters and the unloading area will be CLOSED and monitored by the Danbury Police during all other hours.

UNLOADING: Cyclone Services staff will assist with loads up to 80 pounds. You are expected to help unload your vehicle if you are physically able.

DO NOT BRING: Tires, brush, oil, paint, batteries, boats, vehicles, propane tanks or loose building materials (specifically shingles, drywall or insulation). **All** loose materials must be boxed or bagged.

METAL SCRAPPING: is prohibited and enforced by the police.

NO COMMERCIAL LOADS: This service is for residents only.

STAFF HAS THE RIGHT TO REFUSE ANY LOAD. Cleanup weeks will resume in 2022.

MONTHLY TOWNSHIP MEETINGS are held the 2nd & 4th Wednesdays at 6:00 p.m. in the lower meeting room of Danbury Township Hall at 5972 Port Clinton Eastern Rd. Please check our website for the date of our second meeting in November (due to the Thanksgiving holiday).

BRUSH DROP-OFF at 310 Bridge Rd. (behind the dog park) will remain open until December 15. Residents may drop off limbs and branches during daylight hours. **No stumps or grass clippings.** Loose leaves or leaves in biodegradable bags will be accepted. **NO CONTRACTORS.**

WHO IS PLOWING YOUR STREET THIS WINTER??

State law prohibits the township from plowing private streets. Talk to your neighbors **NOW** about making winter plowing arrangements. EMS & FIRE cannot reach a house or resident if streets & driveways are not plowed. Please help us to save a life or home during the winter.

Recycling of LIVE Christmas trees will be done until January 31 at the fenced area behind the salt shed at Township Hall. Please remove all lights and decorations. And...**PLEASE...watch out for snowplows this winter!!!** Our crews work day and night to keep township roads cleared.

Township Hall is an **EMERGENCY SHELTER** during severe weather. The police will open the hall within a few minutes of the sirens being activated. Sirens are tested at noon on the 1st Friday of each month year-round.



TARGET ENFORCEMENT AREAS

Due to excessive speeding and reckless driving, the Danbury Police will be issuing warnings and ticketing violators on **Buck Road** (north of East Harbor State Park where the speed limit is 40) and on Bayshore by **Meadowbrook Marsh** (speed limit 45 and designated wildlife crossing area).
