WHAT? DANBURY TOWNSHIP CLEAN-UP WEEK!

WHEN? Tuesday, June 21 thru Friday, June 24 from 9 a.m. to 6 p.m. and Saturday, June 25 From 8 a.m. to noon. The site will be closed & monitored by Danbury Police during all other hours.

WHERE? Behind Township Hall - 5972 Port Clinton Eastern Rd.

WHO? Danbury Township and Marblehead Village residents only
Employees from Cyclone Services will be working our two cleanup weeks this year and Danbury Township Maintenance Staff will be onsite.

PLEASE REVIEW THE RULES BELOW

UNLOADING: Cyclone Services staff will assist with loads up to 80 pounds. You are expected to help unload your vehicle if you are physically able.

DO NOT BRING: Tires, brush, oil, paint, batteries, boats, vehicles, propane tanks or loose building materials (specifically shingles, drywall or insulation). All loose materials must be boxed or bagged.

METAL SCRAPPING: is prohibited and enforced by the police.

NO COMMERCIAL LOADS: This service is for residents only.

MAINTENANCE STAFF HAS THE RIGHT TO REFUSE ANY LOAD

Next (and last for 2022) clean-up week: September 27 Thru October 1

Annual cleanup at Sackett Cemetery will be March 28 thru April 1. Please remove what you wish to save prior to then. Easter items may be placed anytime after April 1.

CALL ZONING...

BEFORE you begin your spring & summer projects! Fences, decks, pools, sheds and nearly everything else requires a zoning permit. Office hours are Monday, Tuesday, Thursday and Friday from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m. Wednesdays hours are 9 a.m. to 1 a.m. and 4 p.m. to 6:30 p.m. **(419) 734-6120**. Any changes to office hours are posted on our website, outside the main door and on the answering machine.

RESIDENTS ARE NEEDED AND WANTED

to serve on our zoning boards! Danbury Township must be your residence of record for you to be appointed.
