## DANBURY TOWNSHIP CLEAN-UP WEEK –The last one for 2022

Tuesday, September 27 thru Friday, September 30 from 9 a.m. to 6 p.m.  
*and* Saturday, October 1 from 8 a.m. to noon.

Site is closed & monitored by Danbury Police during all other hours.

Clean-up is located behind Township Hall - 5972 Port Clinton Eastern Rd.

This service is for Danbury Township and Marblehead Village residents only.

Cyclone Services will work clean-up & Danbury Maintenance will assist.

### PLEASE REVIEW OUR RULES

**UNLOADING:** Cyclone Services staff will assist with loads up to 80 pounds. You are expected to help unload your vehicle if you are physically able.

**DO NOT BRING:** Tires, brush, oil, paint, batteries, boats, vehicles, household chemicals, propane tanks or loose building materials (specifically shingles, drywall or insulation).

**All** loose materials must be boxed or bagged. Other trash restrictions may apply.

**METAL SCRAPPING:** is prohibited and enforced by the police.

**NO COMMERCIAL LOADS:** This service is for residents only.

**Danbury Maintenance Staff has the right to refuse to accept a load.**

## NOTICE OF TEMPORARY LOCATION CHANGE FOR TOWNSHIP

### MEETINGS AND SEVERE WEATHER SHELTER UPDATE

Township Hall remains an emergency shelter during severe weather **EXCEPT** not during October & November 2022. The floor in the meeting room is sinking and will be repaired during this time. The new Danbury Fire Station, 7870 E. Harbor Road, will be the temporary location of all township meetings during these 2+ months and will function as a second, and permanent, severe weather shelter. The website will be updated in the event floor construction continues longer than planned. Don't forget —weather warning sirens are tested the first Friday each month at noon.

By the end of August the Danbury Township Fire Department will be moved into their new building. In mid to late fall an open house for residents will be held. The date will be announced on the website, in local papers and on social media.

Former Station 1 on East Harbor Road will be sold to the Lakeside Association. Station 2 on Bridge Road will be retained by the township.

Plans are for it to be utilized by our Road Maintenance Department.

Construction starts on Tuesday, September 6. One lane on SR163 with bi-directional traffic will be maintained via temporary traffic signals. Mid-November is the estimated completion. Both Englebeck and N. Shore will be detoured during construction. Mutach's and Dollar General will be accessible during this time. Details are on the township website home page and include all the information we currently have from ODOT. The website will be updated with all changes.
