

## RESOLUTION NO. 25A-2022

*Authorizing Expenditure from American Rescue Plan Act Funds  
Revising flooring quotes*

*Ottawa County, Ohio*

**Be It Resolved** *by the Township Trustees of Danbury Township*

**WHEREAS**, this date, October 26, 2022, Trustee ROZAK moved the adoption of the following Resolution:

**WHEREAS**, the Township has received a distribution of monies (the “ARPA Funds”) from the American Rescue Plan Act of 2021 (“ARPA” or the “Act”); and

**WHEREAS**, Congress passed the Act effective March 11, 2021; and

**WHEREAS**, Section 603 created the Coronavirus Local Fiscal Recovery Fund which, among other things, appropriated money to cities, nonentitlement units of local government, and counties to mitigate the fiscal effects stemming from the public health emergency with respect to the Coronavirus Disease (Covid-19); and

**WHEREAS**, the Rule further clarifies that recipients can use:

SLFRF funds on government services up to the revenue loss amount, whether that be the standard allowance amount or the amount calculated using the [Final Rule four-step process]. Government services generally include any service traditionally provided by a government, unless treasury has stated otherwise.

**WHEREAS**, “Government services is [deemed by Treasury] the most flexible eligible use category under the SLFRF program, and funds are subject to streamlined reporting and compliance requirements;” and

**WHEREAS**, by way of Resolution 25-2022, the Township approved utilized ARPA funds to repair the Danbury Townhall Meeting Room floor for an amount not to exceed \$93,200 based upon bidding that had been received; and

**WHEREAS**, after the Floor Repair project commenced, the Township was notified of a change work order increasing the Floor Repair cost by \$2,387.00 to pump out an abandoned tank and fill with flowable material and an increase of \$4,081.00 for revision of the foundation details for new shoring drawings, for a total increase of \$6,468.00.

**NOW THEREFORE**, it is hereby RESOLVED by the Board that:

1. The Township elected to use the standard allowance by way of Resolution 03-2022 and 03A-2022 and its presumption of revenue loss due to the public health emergency and to use the amount authorized herein to fund government services.

2. The change orders increasing the cost of the Floor Repair Project are hereby authorized and shall be paid for from the ARPA Funds in the amount of/an amount not to exceed: \$6,468.00.

3. The Project described herein serves the objectives of the Act by providing services traditionally provided by a government, namely:

- Administrative Facilities improvement.

4. Accordingly, the Project is in the best interests of the Township and is deemed a priority for the community.


5. No obligations paid under the authority of this Resolution were incurred prior to March 3, 2021.


6. This Project will be categorized as Expenditure Category EC 6.1 – Provision of Government Services.
