- Accepting only standard glass tube televisions. The District will charge to recycle glass screen TV's
- TV's 24 inches or less—\$5
- TV's 25 inches or more-\$10
- No charge for electronics (LCD/LED or Plasma TV's, computers, CD/DVD players, stereos)



Residential Tire

Registration runs April—May

- Accepting tires on or off the rim.
- Car and small truck tires—\$1 each.
- Racing tires—\$3 each.
- Absolutely no Semi or Tractor tires at this collection—Call the District for disposal options.
- Limit of 10 tires per household.

Hazardous Waste

- Accepting fluorescent/CFL bulbs
- No longer taking Lead Acid ,

 Rechargeable or Alkaline Batteries.
- All automotive fluids & fuels, marine
 auto flares. Motor oil however is
 not accepted.
- Household cleaners, household pesticides/herbicides/fungicides/ insecticides, inhalers & used cooking oil.
- Oil paints, wood stains, aerosols, primers, thinners, strippers, sealers, tars, adhesives and coatings.
- Fluids will not be accepted in containers larger than 5 gallons. No gas canisters or cylinders.
