WHEN? Tuesday, June 20 thru Friday, June 23 from 9 a.m. to 6 p.m. **and** Saturday, June 24 From 8 a.m. to noon. The site will be closed & monitored by Danbury Police during all other hours.

WHERE? Behind Township Hall - 5972 Port Clinton Eastern Rd.

WHO? Danbury Township and Marblehead Village residents only
Employees from Cyclone Services will be working our two cleanup weeks and Danbury Township Maintenance Staff will be onsite.

PLEASE REVIEW THE RULES BELOW

UNLOADING: Cyclone Services staff will assist with loads up to 80 pounds. You are expected to help unload your vehicle if you are physically able.

DO NOT BRING: Tires, brush, oil, paint, batteries, boats, vehicles, household chemicals, propane tanks or loose building materials (specifically shingles, drywall or insulation). **All** loose materials must be boxed or bagged. Questions? Call Maintenance: (419) 734-4091

METAL SCRAPPING: is prohibited and enforced by the police.

NO COMMERCIAL LOADS: This service is for residents only.

SEVERE WEATHER EMERGENCY SHELTER

Township Hall at 5972 Port Clinton Eastern Road **AND** the Danbury Township Fire Station at 7870 East Harbor Road are designated emergency shelters during severe weather. Both buildings will be opened within a few minutes of sirens being activated. Sirens are tested at noon on the 1st Friday each month of the year.

We can load your vehicle for you, while supplies last, from 8 a.m. to 9 a.m. on Mondays beginning April 3 through (and including) September 30 (but not on any legal holidays) and from 8 a.m. to noon, while supplies last, on these Saturdays: April 15 & 29 and May 6 & 20. BEFORE you begin your spring & summer projects! Fences, decks, pools, sheds and nearly everything else requires a zoning permit. Office hours April 1 through October 1 are Tuesday, Thursday & Friday from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m. On Wednesdays, the hours are 9 a.m. to 1 p.m. and 4 p.m. to 6:30 p.m. The office is closed on Mondays. Any changes to office hours are posted on our website, outside the main door and on the answering machine. Office hours for the winter months will be published in our fall newsletter.
