DANBURY TOWNSHIP CLEAN-UP WEEK –The last one for 2023

Tuesday, September 19 thru Friday, September 22 from 9 a.m. to 6 p.m. and Saturday, September 23 from 8 a.m. to noon. Clean-up weeks will resume in 2024. Site is closed & monitored by Danbury Police during all other hours. Clean-up is located behind Township Hall at 5972 Port Clinton Eastern Rd. This service is for Danbury Township and Marblehead Village residents only. Cyclone Services will work clean-up and Danbury Maintenance will assist.

PLEASE REVIEW OUR RULES

UNLOADING: Cyclone Services staff will assist with loads up to 80 pounds. You are expected to help unload your vehicle if you are physically able.

DO NOT BRING: Tires, brush, oil, paint, batteries, boats, vehicles, household chemicals, propane tanks or loose building materials (specifically shingles, drywall or insulation). **NO COMMERCIAL LOADS:** Residents only. **ALL** loose materials must be boxed or bagged. Other trash restrictions may apply.

METAL SCRAPPING: is prohibited and enforced by the police. Danbury Maintenance may refuse to accept a load.

MANY THANKS to OSS Solid Waste District for a grant to purchase 4 recycled material trash receptacles (3 for Sackett & 1 for Meadowbrook) **AND** 3 "walk-in" picnic tables for Meadowbrook.

When sirens are sounded (except for the monthly test on the 1st Friday at noon), **ONLY THE FRONT DOOR UNDER THE ARCH** at Township Hall & the Fire Station will be opened. This allows our staff to quickly direct residents to the safest area.





IS THERE A NUISANCE property next door with tall grass over 12", junk vehicles or boats, miscellaneous debris & junk or an unsafe dilapidated structure? If you live within 500 feet of a nuisance property, file a "Nuisance Complaint Form" available on the township website under "Violations" on the Zoning Department's page and return it to the Zoning Office to get the process started. Due to Ohio Revised Code and State requirements, nuisance complaints take time to administer to give due process to the owner to correct the issue on their own. Don't wait until the last minute to file!

BRUSH DROP-OFF

at 310 Bridge Road is open until December 1. This service is for residents only.

FREE MULCH IS STILL AVAILABLE at the brush site. We also load vehicles by appointment.
