UNLOADING: Cyclone Services staff will assist with loads up to 80 pounds. You are expected to help unload your vehicle if you are physically able.

DO NOT BRING: Tires, brush, oil, paint, batteries, boats, vehicles, household chemicals, propane tanks or loose building materials (specifically shingles, drywall or insulation). Box or bag **All** loose materials.

METAL SCRAPPING: Prohibited and enforced by the police. NO COMMERCIAL LOADS: Residents ONLY.

ENTER THE DOORS UNDER THE ARCHWAY.

Sirens are tested at noon on the 1st Friday each month of the year.
