Applicants are to limit their testimony to <u>fifteen (15) minutes</u>, including any information presented by his/her duly appointed agent or attorney. Other persons with standing to testify are to limit their remarks to <u>three (3) minutes or less</u>. These limitations may be extended if the Board requests or approves further testimony.
