DANBURY TOWNSHIP CLEAN-UP WEEK!

Tuesday, June 23 thru Friday, June 26 from 9 a.m. to 6 p.m. **AND** Saturday, June 27 from 8 a.m. to noon. The site is closed & monitored by Danbury Police all other hours.

Clean-ups are behind Township Hall - 5972 Port Clinton Eastern Rd. and are for Danbury Township and Marblehead Village residents only.

Employees from Rumpke will work our 2 cleanup weeks and Township Maintenance staff will be onsite.

HERE ARE THE RULES

UNLOAD: Staff will assist with loads up to 80 pounds. You are expected to help unload your vehicle if you are able.

DO NOT BRING: Tires, brush, oil, paint, batteries, boats, vehicles, propane tanks, household chemicals or loose building materials (specifically shingles, insulation or drywall). **All** loose materials must be boxed or bagged.

METAL SCRAPPING: is prohibited and enforced by the police.

NO COMMERCIAL LOADS OR CONTRACTORS: This service is for residents only.

Call Maintenance with questions: (419) 734-4091 We have the right to refuse any load.

SEVERE WEATHER EMERGENCY SHELTER

Township Hall at 5972 Port Clinton Eastern Road **AND** the Danbury Township Fire Station at 7870 East Harbor Road are designated emergency shelters during severe weather events. Both buildings are opened shortly after the outdoor warning sirens are activated.

ENTER THE MAIN DOORS UNDER THE ARCH. Sirens are tested at noon on the 1st Friday each month of the year.



BRUSH DROP-OFF IS OPEN at 310 Bridge Rd. behind the dog park.

Residents may drop off limbs & branches during daylight hours.

NO stumps and **NO** grass clippings.

Loose leaves or leaves in biodegradable bags are accepted in April & May.

BEFORE you begin your spring & summer projects!

Fences, decks, pools, sheds and nearly everything else requires a zoning permit. Office hours are Tuesday, Thursday & Friday from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m. On Wednesdays, the hours are 9 a.m. to 11 a.m. and 4 p.m. to 6:30 p.m. The office is closed on Mondays. Any changes to office hours are posted on our website, outside the main door and on the answering machine.

FREE MULCH! Help yourself at the brush drop-off site during daylight hours. We can load your vehicle for you, while supplies last, from 8 a.m. to 9 a.m. on Mondays starting April 6 through (and including) September 28 (but not on legal holidays) and from 8 a.m. to 10 a.m. while supplies last, on these Saturdays: April 11 & 25 and May 2. We also load vehicles by appointment. **Call us at: (419) 734-4091**

In February, our staff planted native grasses and wildflowers in the Roundabout center circle using seeds harvested from Meadowbrook Marsh.
